Ballot Initiated District

- Sec. 5-8-73 Designation of permit parking districts;
 notice of designation
- The City Manager may recommend locations be designated as an RPP district if located within one mile of an existing or proposed transit station
- The Director of Transportation and Environmental Services shall mail a ballot to all residential properties within the proposed permit parking district
 - If more than 50% of ballots are returned, and more than 60% of those returned ballots indicate support for creating an RPP district, the City Manager shall certify this fact to the TPB

District Need

- Proximity to future Potomac Yard Metro Station anticipated to open in fall 2022
- Mitigate commuter parking

Ballot Process

- Delivered ballots to USPS for mailing to all residential properties in proposed area in late February, 2022
 - Provided options to return ballots by mail, email, or online form
- Sample ballot shown on next slide
- Requested responses by March 28, 2022
- Coordinated with Potomac Greens Homeowner's Association to send residents information and to answer questions from residents

Next Steps

- City Code Requirements:
 - >50% of addresses respond; >60% of respondents vote 'yes.'
- If residents approve of the Potomac Greens RPP district,
 City staff estimates that the neighborhood streets will be be posted with restrictions in the Summer of 2022
 - City staff recommend 2-hour restrictions Monday through Saturday
 8 a.m. to 11 p.m. except holders of District 14 permits
 - Petitions requesting customized restrictions would go through the standard petitioning process with the Traffic and Parking Board
- RPP District will be operational before the Metro station opens
- · 'Go Live' date for enforcement, permits to be determined
