Subject: Noise Variance Permit –April 2022

Residents:

Potomac Yard Constructors (PYC) has applied for a noise variance permit for night work as described below. The scope of work consists of erecting a structural support frame integral to operation of the new station and WMATA tracks. This work is required to take place at night due to WMATA regulations regarding work within the active roadway. Note, the work may not be continuous due to weather and availability of CSX/WMATA work windows.

Dates of work and anticipated activities:

April 15th through April 16th: Erection and placement of structural steel frame within WMATA roadway.
Work Hours: 6:00pm on Friday, April 15th through – 9:00am Saturday April 16th. Work will be performed around the clock.

Activity: Erection and placement of structural steel frame within WMATA roadway.

Location: Station site area and the rail corridor.

What Residents Can Expect:

Work Site: Light tower and Heavy equipment/Crane noise throughout the evening. PYC will ensure that, without compromising a safe working environment, the light towers will be pointed away from residents' homes as much as practicable.
